Presentations options are:

- **Plenary** (60 mins)
- Talk (60 or 40 mins)
- **Workshop** (60 or 40 mins): workshop sessions must include active audience participation through experiencing and discussing tasks provided by the workshop facilitator.
- **Live Lesson** (60 or 40 mins): workshops with real learners (various age groups). Lessons are observed by attendees of the conference. The organisers can provide groups of learners.
- Advanced Lessons for Teachers (60 or 40 min.): workshops with active participation of teachers attendees of the conference who would like to polish up their English

The language of the conference is **English**. A separate slot of presentations is planned to be run in **Polish**.

Summary of sessions

You are asked to submit a 60-word summary of the content and structure of your session and provide biodata: (max. 60 words). Presentations will be chosen based on your summary, which must accurately reflect the content of your presentation. The programme committee will evaluate all speaker proposals based on quality and relevance.
